NSSSED’s Be@the Farm is a Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) entity that is similar to a booster club at other schools or districts.

Our partnership with Wagner Farm provides an opportunity for NSSSED students to receive agricultural instruction outside of the school setting and a community-based experience that supports overall skill development for their future endeavors.

The program will provide Wagner Farm the establishment of an ongoing exhibit in their greenhouse and the potential development of a FFA site (Future Farmers of America.)

An additional benefit of the program is the opportunity it provides for members of the general public to be involved with our students, through volunteer and booster club support.
